## **HOW YOU CAN STOP TITAN CEMENT**

**Call Governor Bev Perdue (919-733-5811)** and tell her why **you oppose the Titan Cement project**. Ask the Governor to **halt all permits until the SBI completes the ongoing investigation** into inappropriate political influence surrounding the Titan air permit. Tell the Governor to **enforce the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA)**—a state law that originally applied to this project and would have forced Titan to wait on all permits until the full state and federal environmental review process is complete.

**Call your US Senators and Representative** and ask them to **support new regulations proposed by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) which will force US cement kilns to reduce their current toxic emissions by up to 80-90%**. The cement industry is fighting these regulations and their lobbyists are telling our elected officials the industry cannot comply. We know they can, but they won't unless EPA makes them. Senator Kay Hagen's number is 202-224-6342. Senator Richard Burr's number is 202-224-3154. Congressman Mike McIntyre's number is 202-225-2731.

And speaking of elected officials, there are some big races this November, both locally and in DC. We'll post any information we find about where candidates stand on the Titan issue. **Make sure you ask each candidate their position on Titan Cement and let them know you're not voting for anybody that supports Titan Cement.**
